Stabling: \$20.00; \$35.00 (section 5)

1) ENTRIES: Entry fees include a \$25 non-refundable office fee. **Note:** USEA and USEF fees are not included as part of the entry fee; these fees should be added to your entry fee, per the itemized "Fees Enclosed" section of the Entry Form, totaled with the other applicable fees, and sent to the event with your entry. Use the **2007 Horse trials Entry and Stabling Forms**, and include a **copy of negative Coggins** within the last 12 months. Health Certificate required for all out-of-state horses: bring with you. In the event of a Vesicular Stomatitis outbreak, Health Certificates must include a VS statement, and may be required for in-state horses also. All attachments must be included with entry. Failure to do so could result in denial of the entry. Incomplete entries will be returned.

Double entries: Not accepted.

Changes: \$30 per horse/rider per division after C.D., space permitting.

Other requirements: All Preliminary riders must be a USEF member or pay a USEF \$20 non-member fee and \$5 discipline fee (if applicable). Preliminary competitors include copies of the USEF card with entry.

All competitors must be USEA members; however, BN competitors may \$25 non-member fee.

State birth date on entry.

\$5 charge for lost pinny.

Management reserves right to combine, split, or cancel classes; cancel or add judges as entries warrant, and refuse any entries.

Refunds: Before C.D.-Less \$25 non-refundable office fee; After C.D.-Entry at discretion of organizing committee with vet/physician certificate.

Competition cancellation-No refund.

2) TENTATIVE TIME SCHEDULE:

Fri: Show Office & Stabling open at noon; Cross-country course open-3 pm. Competitors' meeting & official course walk-6 pm.

Sat: Dressage-8 am; Cross-country-noon; and Show Jumping-2 pm; Competitor's Party/BBQ-6 pm.

3) AWARDS: Prize money for top three places in each division donated by Mears Morgans and area sponsors. Award first place each division. Ribbons to 6th place.

4) STARTING TIMES: Available after August 20 on www.windywyoming.com or from sec'y; post-cards will be sent.

5) STABLING/VETERINARIAN: \$20/night or \$35 for weekend, 60 12x12 uncovered pens on grounds (you may bring your own tarp)-first come first served based on mailed entry. Bedding provided. Hay available for purchase. **Send stabling form & fee with entry.**

From I-80: Take Snowy Range exit #311, stay on Hwy 230 west for 8 1/2 miles. Turn left off Hwy 230 at "Mears Morgans" sign (opposite Cnty. Rd. 43 sign). Follow markers for 0.5 miles to Mears Morgans Barns.

8) DRESSAGE: *Test & arena sizes:* P-2006 USEF Preliminary Test A-Sm. T-2006 USEF Training Test A-Sm. N-2006 USEF Novice Test A-Sm. BN-2006 USEF Beginner Novice Test A-Sm. *Arenas:* Coarse sand arenas.

9) **CROSS-COUNTRY:** Approximate course specifications: P-2800 m @ 520 mpm. T-2400 m @ 450 mpm. N-2000 m @ 350 mpm. BN-1900 m @ 300 mpm. (Distance and speed subject to change). *Terrain:* Cross-country on river bottom with cottonwood trees with natural, gravel river crossing. P/T/N/BN: Average difficulty for horses with some experience at these levels.
